SLC DEBATE 2025 MOTIONS

The motions will be debated in the order listed below:

MOTION 1

Assuming the creation of such technology were possible, THW prohibit the permanent shutdown or disconnection of Als with a high capacity to emulate human consciousness.

MOTION 2

THB that governments should discourage the acquisition of virtual reality (VR) and augmented reality (AR) technologies for recreational purposes.

MOTION 3

TH, as the European Union, would impose severe economic sanctions on Israel in response to the recent humanitarian crisis in the West Bank and Gaza.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Micro-apartments are residential spaces smaller than 60m², usually designed as lofts (without separate rooms) or with only one bedroom.

MOTION 4

TH regrets the rise of micro-apartment construction in major Latin American cities.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

For the purpose of this debate, science has developed the "severance" technology, inspired by the Severance series. This procedure artificially splits a person's consciousness into two separate entities: one that exists exclusively during working hours (Intus), and one that lives the person's private life outside of work, retaining all memories and emotions (Exus). Both entities share the same body but have no access to each other's memories, emotions, or experiences.

Although the technology is recent, clinical trials show medical complications are rare. The procedure has been approved for commercialization, with initial implementation targeted at high-stress or high-confidentiality workplaces.
